



High Holydays 2018 Guest Ticket Request Form

A limited number of guest tickets will be available for family and friends of members of NNLS. They will cost £45.00 each for immediate family (parent, child, sibling, spouse), and £85.00 each for other guests. Tickets will cover the whole of the High Holydays. Although there is no charge for children of members under 21, those between 12 - 17 will be issued with their own youth ticket and those between 18 and 21 will get an adult ticket. There is no charge for members of other Masorti Synagogues and for non-member students and young adults aged 18 - 25.

If you wish to purchase a guest ticket/s please complete the slip below and return it to the synagogue office (80 East End Road N3 2SY) **NO LATER THAN 13th AUGUST** together with your cheque, if you are not paying by bank transfer (see below). Requests for tickets will be dealt with on a first come first served basis.

Tickets are valid for all services, Traditional and Egalitarian, and are spread across various different venues. Due to capacity limitations we cannot guarantee a seat at any particular service.

For security reasons all members and visitors will need a valid ticket otherwise they may be refused entry
